- **1.** <u>Advertising</u> is far-reaching and is accomplished using brochures, flyers, websites, social media, radio, and through the online <u>Indiana Festival and Travel Guide</u>.
- Booth Opening Times. All booths are expected to be open and 'ready for business' by 4:30 PM on Friday,
 9:00 AM on Saturday, and 10:00 AM on Sunday. Friday's initial set-up time begins at 12:00 Noon. Please refrain from arriving too early.
- **3. Booth Sizes and Fees.** Two booth sizes are available. If your booth does not fit these sizes, accommodation can be made provided notification is given when submitting the registration form.

10' deep by 10' wide is \$45. 10' deep by 20' wide is \$80.

4. <u>Electrical Hook Ups.</u> Electricity is available for an additional fee. All vendors must bring their own extension cords. No spliced or daisy chain extension cords are allowed.

- 5. <u>Deposit Fee</u>—<u>Nonfood vendors</u> must include a separate \$25 deposit check with the registration form. This check will be returned if the vendor stays all three days. Vendors leaving before 2:00 PM on Sunday will forfeit this deposit. Deposit checks can be picked up at the festival's information booth.
 <u>Food vendors</u> are required to include a \$40 deposit check with the registration form. All food vendors are required to give the festival 10% of their gross sales. The deposit fee will be applied toward the 10% gross at the close of the festival.
- **6.** <u>Fire Extinguishers--</u> According to the International Fire Code, food booths having hazard areas including deep fryers, must have a Class K fire extinguisher in the booth. This extinguisher must have a tag indicating it has been inspected within the year. All other vendors must have an ABC type extinguisher with them.

7. General Guidelines for All Participants.

- Proof of insurance and all necessary permits are available upon request. Food booths will be inspected by the County Health Officer.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting taxes on sales, maintaining clean booths, and sweeping the space before leaving.
- The Festival Committee has exclusive authority to determine the acceptability of materials.
- Disruptive behavior, the sale of knives to those under the age of 18, smoking on the streets, silly string, snap pops, and similar items are prohibited.
- All pets must be leashed.
- Pellet guns may be sold providing the vendor posts signage stating guns cannot be opened on festival streets during the festival. Guns will be confiscated and held until the end of the festival if the purchaser does not comply.
- Security is provided throughout the festival, including after-hours.
